To help prevent duplication of counts of huge flocks by two or more field parties, we ask you to fill out this form. The main species occurring in huge flocks are American Robin, Tree Swallow, Fish Crow, and gulls.

Gulls occur in mixed-species flocks. As a rough estimate, about 80% of our larger gulls are Ring-bills and only 20% Herring Gulls — often difficult to separate in flight where relative sizes are hard to judge. Laughing Gulls are smaller, have darker mantles, and are fairly easy to separate from the larger gulls by plumage characteristics.
